# BITA UNRAVELED DELITIGE

## BHANGRA UNWRAPPED looks

at the role fabric plays within Asian Culture. Workshops will first examine visual motifs and stereotypes and use them to print fabric for use during digital imaging sessions. These sessions will investigate different ways of wrapping fabric to produce artworks in the form of still and moving image sequences that explore attitudes towards the genre.
